Loving Sai Ram and Greetings of the day!

I thank you all for your active participation in the online survey. I went through the feedbacks and have worked out what we may collectively do to ensure that we minimize the difficulties and hardships that we are facing while dealing with the technology-based teaching learning process. Below in the second column of the table is the detailed description of the feedback received and in the third column responses to specific feedbacks. The section that follows after this is a SWOC analysis and clearly helps us understand our Strengths, our Weaknesses, our Opportunities and our Challenges that we are facing or lie ahead of us.

Responses to feedbacks

01	We should be provided with better technological facilities from school so that we can reach the students more easily through online modes.	State-of-the-art on line public communication platforms are already in place. Apart from those, the school has invested lakhs of rupees for setting up and installing Tata ClassEdge products to be used for effective teaching learning in the school. www.tataclassedgeonline.com , the online version of Tata ClassEdge is the most appropriate technology which the school already has in place to be used by the teachers.
02	We need more planning and preparation for this kind of uncertain circumstances. If these kinds of circumstances occur again, we have to work as a team as one family.	I salute the foresightedness of former Principal Madam and staff of the school in anticipating that the mode of education in the future would not just be classroom based but would also involve the internet and distance would no matter what far, impact/effect teaching learning between the teacher and the taught. Tata ClassEdge was the foresightedness that all of you collectively had.
03	For mathematics part solution for each and every question is not possible to find on the net. Students seek answers from teacher but they are not able to ask such problems.	If we could manage to get teachers hand books for various subjects then it would help us tremendously in ensuring the stepwise solutions are communicated to the students. The office had communicated the book suppliers regarding the same, however due to the lockdown they haven't reached us yet. I had forwarded a message in the official Whatsapp group, that I received from Mr. Tungish Mitra on how through Tata ClassEdge online, Mathematics teachers are teaching lessons. The way we were not trained in teaching and guiding students online, the students were also not trained to shift the mode. We need to train ourselves in the art and also train students how to respond to this new method of teaching learning. The onus of preparing ourselves and the students lies on all of us in a formal and well-planned set-up.

The other problem is with the cost of internet packs which some parents may not be able to purchase frequently. Child of a parent who could afford and fulfil all the above will not have any problem in guiding the child in accordance to the guidance by the school, but the child falling in the first category would remain deprived...How do we solve this keeping in mind, the very objective of the foundation of our School? Education should be all inclusive.
06	If software will be provided than we can be in touch with each and every student	The software that is most efficient is Whatsapp, The Tata ClassEdge also has a similar communication platform, we may expedite with concern from the TCE about its usage.
07	I would like to inform the administration that TATA class are not opening in phones. and it doesn't work in some phone. Syllabus of class 2 is missing in TCE. It would be of great help to student and teachers if administration looks after this matter.	This is already communicated and I am hopeful it starts working soon. Any android phone will support www.tataclassedgeonline.com . We may have to download certain plugins which the phone would prompt the user. Download and install the plugin as suggested and there shouldn't be any problem after that.
08	My suggestion is that parents should also actively participate and few parents are not responding and for videos Tata class videos are not working in some mobiles. Click the class icon and you are navigated to a new page https://ncert.online/cbse/gema/ . On the page a prompt appears suggesting you for (Add 89056 29969 in Your Class Whatsapp Group to Get Video Solutions of Maths). You can find Chapter pdf., NCERT solutions, Objective questions & subjective questions for all subjects except Nepali and the information for IX and X English are not yet uploaded. For those subjects whose data are available, I found the materials to be of extremely good quality. You may also visit NCERT official YouTube channel. The NCERT frequently uploads data created for dissemination to teachers and students and are available in the portal for download and use.

We would also initiate feedback on administrative processes and the staff and other support services staff by students, teachers and parents soon. 19	We must take attendance of the student and be strict against the student who are not present during classes...it will be good if u tell teacher to take class according to your plan chart...	Please refer Serial No. 16. Instead of focusing on attendance it would be better if we focus on submission of the work the teacher asks the students to submit. Teachers may keep a record of submission of the work by students and appropriately use as an alternative to attendance. Here learning and promptness by the student accounts and not the attendance.

SWOC (Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Challenges) ANALYSIS

Opportunities

1. Creation of quality online resources by the teachers.
2. Creation of the school YouTube channel for the benefit of stakeholders.
3. Starting community radio for the benefit of society on various matters that we hold expertise on.
4. Setting up a recording room for creating online resources and making the community radio functional.
5. Providing training to teachers in using computers more efficiently.
6. Providing training to teachers on handling technology in a more meaningful manner and enhancement of technological acumen.
7. Creating online teaching resources for local language-based subjects. For example, Nepali language has tremendous scope and our school could lead the way in creation of online resources in Nepali for the benefit of all.
8. Dissemination of Bal Vikas / Value-oriented lessons to students at least once a week.

Challenges

1. Setting up a plan for successful transitional adaptation to new means of teaching learning in a prescribed manner.
2. Lack of promptness in accepting directions from the administration.
3. Lack of personal technological devices like laptops etc.
4. Bridging the gap of technological know-how by the staff in this current situation of lock down.
